

Mayor's Christmas Card Competition

Conditions of Entry

General

1. The Competition is being run by the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters, 175 the Parade, Norwood SA 5067 (ABN 11390194824) ('the Council').
2. Entries for the Competition open at 12pm, Monday 12 August 2024 and close at 5pm, Monday 16 September 2024. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. The Competition is open to all students from Reception to Year 6 who live or go to school in the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters.

Entering

4. To enter the Competition, an entrant must submit the official Entry Form to the Council with an original drawing, painting or digital drawing that reflects the theme, 'what Christmas means to you', by the Closing Date and Time.
5. Entries are limited to one (1) per person.

Prize

6. The Prize means:
 - 1st place - voucher valued at \$100;
 - 2nd place - voucher valued at \$75; and
 - 3rd place - voucher valued at \$50,with the voucher to be provided by a business within the City of Norwood Payneham & St Peters, to be determined by the Council.
7. The Prize for 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place will be awarded to entrants from each year level (Reception to Year 6).
8. The Council reserves the right to substitute the Prize with another prize of equal or greater value.
9. The Mayor's Choice Winner (overall prize winner) of the Competition will have their entry featured on the front cover of the December edition of the Council's newsletter, *Look East*.
10. The winning entry from each year level will be printed onto Christmas Cards with the winner's first name, year and school name printed, for use by the Mayor, Chief Executive Officer and General Managers for distribution to other Councils, government agencies, schools, community groups and individuals on behalf of the Council.
